



SANTA FE COUNTY VISITOR SCREENING PROTOCOL

To do our part in preventing the spread of COVID-19 in our community and workplace, we are restricting access to this facility for anyone who may have recently been exposed to the virus, who has traveled out of state within the past fourteen days, and/or who is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. A positive response to any of the following questions will result in denial of entry into any Santa Fe County building, as will a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher.

Are you currently required to quarantine for any reason, including because you have been out of New Mexico? Yes No

Do you live with someone or have you visited someone who is subject to self-isolation or self-quarantine, including someone who must quarantine due to traveled out of state within the last fourteen days? Yes No

Have you taken a fever reducing medication in the past eight hours? Yes No

Do you currently have any of the following potential COVID-19 symptoms that are unexplained by other medical diagnosis or chronic condition, such as seasonal allergies or asthma (place a check next to each symptom the visitor has):
